



Adaptive Strategy, Development, Planning, and Assessment

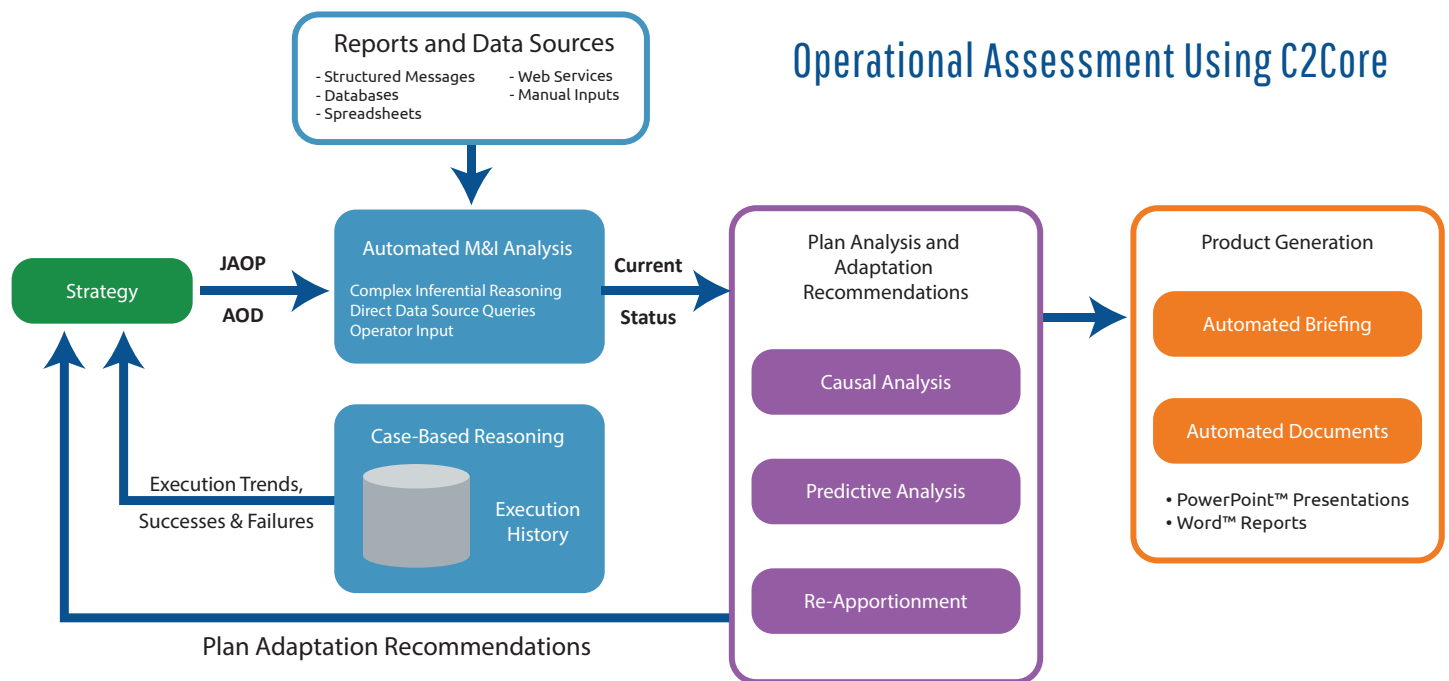
Advanced Capability for Understanding and Managing Effects Networks (ACUMEN) enables strategic plan development, assessment, and tracking in support of an adaptive planning process. It is a versatile, operationally fielded solution that has been effectively demonstrated in multiple domains, to include air operations, humanitarian assistance, civil affairs, and information operations.

ACUMEN provides a unified view of continuous effects-based planning and assessment for operations centers. The system is a generic, structured framework that allows operators to perform strategic planning, operational assessment, data analysis, correlation, and progress calculation within one tool. ACUMEN provides the ability to integrate kinetic/non-kinetic and lethal/non-lethal operational assessments.

Evaluate planning processes to determine:

- How well is the current plan going, and can the plan be improved?
- What are the lessons learned from executing previous plans?
- How can the lessons learned improve performance on current/future conflicts?

- Automatically associate data with strategy elements
- Track and act on plan elements
- Identify areas of concern
- Provide plan visibility across all organization levels
- Perform objective and subjective assessments
- Reduce workload through workflow automation
- Integrate multiple data sources through SOA
